Please find the stakeholder report for the UPR 3rd Cycle Turkey session submitted by the Human Rights Association (İnsan Hakları Derneği - İHD) / Turkey attached.

İHD is a non-governmental, independent, and voluntary body. The association, which was founded in 1986 by 98 human rights defenders, today has 28 branches, 6 representative offices, and 7,945 members. İHD is the oldest and largest HR organization in Turkey. İHD issues special reports on various human rights issues including annual reports on human rights violations in Turkey. These include but are not limited to freedom of speech, the legal system, impunity, enforced disappearances, killings by unknown assailants, extrajudicial executions, torture and ill-treatment, condition in prisons, and notably gross human rights violations in places where curfews were declared. İHD also submits shadow reports before committees at the United Nations and the Council of Europe.

In this respect, İHD involves the UPR procedures as an individual HR organisation as well as a part of coalition of CSOs submitting joint report to the UPR.
