Annex -4: Information on GBV against women and children

- Bangladesh Shishu Odhikar Forum (BSAF) informed that 3,589 children were abused in 2016; among them 1,441 were victims of unnatural death, 64 were murdered by their parents and 686 were sexually abused.
- Ain o Salish Kendra said in 2016, 415 child were murdered, 22 committed suicide and 28 died due to mysterious reason where 176 cases were filed. As many as 1,034 incidents of violence against children including physical and mental abuse, rape, sexual assault, stalking etc. occurred this year and only 260 cases were filed against those. In 2016 the total number of rape was 724 and among them 251 were children. During January to March 2017 total 27 were raped and sadly, among them 20 were children.
- According to BMP, more than 1,000 women and girl child have been raped in 2016, among them 166 were gang raped and 44 were killed after being raped, another 165 were rape attempts.

- ASK said in 2016, 244 women were victim of sexual harassment and stalking in educational institute and workplaces. Among them, 6 committed suicide, 7 men and 7 women were murdered and 138 were assaulted due to protest against stalking. Five girl students had to stop going school.
