 2 The Cincinnati Empowerment Zone doing business as Friends of The African Union Global Solutions Center  
 3 (hereinafter “FAU”) is an American based economic, social, humanitarian, charitable, educational and new media  
 4 civil-society ruling body founded to work for the benefit of the people of the African Union (hereinafter “AU”) and  
 5 the African diaspora in their host countries, such as Mexico (over a million people of the African Diaspora).

6 New Future Foundation, Inc. (hereinafter “NFF”), a civil society organization in Consultative Status with ECOSOC  
 7 as a not-for-profit organization successfully uses cultural pride, individual initiative, and neighborhood leadership,  
 8 especially among young people. NFF conducts exchange students programs from Africa, ignorance.

 15 She graduated from the Franciscan Handmaids of Mary College in 1965 with a Bachelor  
 16 of Science Degree in Religious Studies. In 2017 NFF Chairwoman Queen Mother Dr.  
 17 Blakely led a delegation that was recognized by the Chairman of Africa Week 2017 on  
 18 Oct 16th 2017 as representing all of African Civil Society. The New Future Foundation  
 19 delegation included the Cincinnati Empowerment Corporation/FAU Global Operations  
 20 Center, FAU EDcorp, Inc, FAU USA Bureau, Congress of Black Native Americans, Infinity  
 21 Building Economics/Black Political Action Committee, the FAU Mighty Forefront, Black  
 22 Methodist for Church Renewal Chapter of Keys of the Kingdom, a United Methodist  
 23 Church, Lord and Blessing Services Group, Inc and Caddo Assets-Services Help (C.A.S.H.)  
 24 Community Development Organization.

 26 Lara, who together have prepared this document as an extension of that answer based on the over 5.8M adult  
 27 Mexican citizens who are external migrants and living in the USA illegally. Furthermore, they are part of the people  
 28 in the USA of Mexican heritage, including over 22 million American citizens, who have experienced this
